

Excavated the Great Kiva

Dr. and Mrs. Edgar L. Hewett have returned to Santa Fe from the field work in the Chaco Canyon. The greater part of the effort by the expedition of the School of American Research and the Museum of New Mexico this fall was devoted to the cleaning out of the great kiva at Chetro Kettle (sic). It is by far the largest kiva yet excavated. Steps were taken immediately to conserve its walls and to protect it from deterioration.
